

125 mm ROUND WITH HOLLOW-CHARGE PROJECTILE

125 mm round with hollow-charge is with separate loading. The round is intended for direct fire against tanks, self-propelled artillery equipment and other armoured targets with powerful armour protection. The hollow-charge projectiles penetrate armour of tanks regardless of the firing distance. They defeat targets consealed in log-and-earth shelters, brick and reinforced concrete fortifications.
